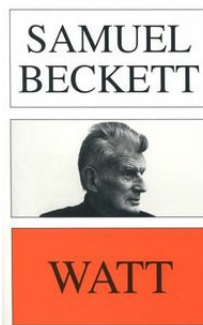


# WATT
