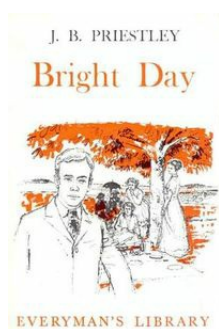


BRIGHT DAY
